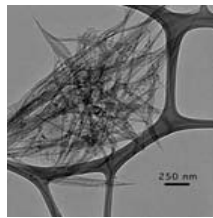
The AIE Postgraduate Awards promote the interaction of postgraduate research students with the energy community in an informal environment and presents AIE members and the public with an excellent opportunity to assess the range and quality of energy research currently under way. Presentations are anticipated from a wide range of research fields: non-technical (social, legal and economic studies) and technical (renewables, fossil fuels, storage, materials, efficiency, design, environment, transport, power).

The poster presentations will be on display throughout the All-Energy Exhibition and students should be available explain their posters in the breaks between conference sessions. A panel of judges will evaluate the students and their displays for the allocation of several awards ranging from \$500 to \$1000 in relevant energy project categories. **The Award winners will be announced in the final session of the All-Energy Conference.**

Student exhibitors will receive an initial complimentary membership of the AIE and award winners will receive a travel allowance to represent Victoria at the AIE National Postgraduate Awards in Adelaide at the AIE National Conference from Monday 15th to Tuesday 16th November 2010.

Entry to the All-Energy Conference and Exhibition is free but pre-registration at www.all-energy.com.au is recommended. No AIE registration is necessary to ATTEND All-Energy but we encourage members to make the most of the free registration available for both the Exhibition and Conference.

Conditions of Entry for the Awards:

To enter for the Awards, students must:

- be enrolled in a postgraduate degree in with an energy related project in a tertiary institution
 - submit an entry form for the AIE Postgraduate Awards (not the presentation itself) to the address below by **5 pm Friday 3rd September 2010**.
 - submit an A4 summary sheet for printing by **5 pm Friday 24th September 2010**.
 - present their project in person with **a poster, a printed copy of the summary sheet and by personal explanation, particularly during session breaks in the All-Energy Conference on Wed 6th & Thu 7th October 2010**.
1. The topic of the project must be related to energy. Based on the range of energy projects submitted, categories will be decided to give all participants a comparable chance of winning and award.
 2. The poster presentation must be based on the personal research of the student, but reference should be made to the supervisor, other co-workers, the department and institution.
 3. There are no facilities for computer based presentations although printouts can be reproduced in the posters.
 4. Several Awards will be presented ranging in value from \$500 to \$1,000.
 5. Major award winners will be invited to represent Victoria at the AIE National Student Awards to be held in conjunction with the AIE National Conference in Adelaide on 15th and 16th November 2010. A travel allowance of \$500 will be provided to the selected students who participate in Adelaide as well as a complimentary student registration to the conference.
 6. Award winners may be asked to cooperate with their sponsor for follow up promotional activities or even recruitment interviews.

A panel of judges chosen by the AIE will assess the presentations and decide the award winners for presentation at the end of the function. The judges' decision will be final and no negotiations will be entered into.
