



## South Australian Energy Project of the Year - 2019

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### CALL FOR NOMINATIONS

The Australian Institute of Energy (South Australia Branch) (AIE) presents annual awards to recognise achievers and contributors to the South Australian energy sector. The awards are presented at the SA Energy Awards Dinner, this year to be held on **Wednesday 17 July 2019** at the National Wine Centre in Adelaide. One of the awards is the **SA Energy Project of the Year**.

Projects may include any professional discipline that has contributed to energy related outcomes such as research, policy, legal, commercial, technological, engineering and construction etc.

The AIE invites eligible applicants to apply for the 2019 Award. The Award will be presented to the principals of the most significant and successful recent energy-related project.

### AWARD ELIGIBILITY

In order to be eligible for the South Australian Energy Project of the Year Award the nominated project candidate must:

- have demonstrably achieved its main objectives prior to nomination submission;
- have been completed in South Australia or apply technology and/or knowledge that was developed in South Australia;
- have been submitted to the AIE and/or the Award accepted by the organisation(s) responsible for the project; and
- the organisation(s) responsible for the project must not have previously received this award for the same project.

### JUDGING CRITERIA GUIDELINES

#### 1 Impact

- Contribution to the sustainable development and/or utilisation of Australia's energy resources.
- Contribution to long-term energy security, reliability and affordability.
- Benefit to the South Australian community, which includes energy outcomes as well as (a) jobs, (b) extent of local content/contribution and (c) adding to the skills base.





## 2 Innovation

- Originality, innovation and entrepreneurship.
- Does the entry represent a clear "break" with previously established methods or processes?
- Does the entry significantly simplify or improve something?
- The innovation is cost-effective and sustainable.
- The project's ability to shape a new standard or approach in the industry and the impact that the new approach could have.

## 3 Success

- The project was delivered safely, on time, on budget and with no adverse environment incidents or impacts.
- The project is achieving/has achieved its stated aims.

The Award Judging Panel retains the discretion to consider broader context/benefit in assessing nominations. As such, nominees are encouraged to address any broader benefits of the project, where relevant, to support their nomination.

The AIE retains the right, at its sole discretion, to not grant an award for SA Energy Project of the Year in 2019.

## NOMINATION PROCESS

Nominations are to be in the form of a written submission that must include:

- A statement (maximum 2,000 words) that describes the project and how it meets the eligibility and judging criteria;
- Details of the organisations involved in the project; and
- Contact details for at least two referees who can adequately discuss the nature and benefit of the project's contribution.

**The judging panel may choose to shortlist projects and request additional information prior to selecting a winner.**

Nominations, including the attached cover sheet, must be submitted by 5:00 pm Tuesday 11th June 2019 via email to The Secretary, AIE SA Branch at [adel@aie.org.au](mailto:adel@aie.org.au) with the words 'SA ENERGY PROJECT OF THE YEAR NOMINATION' in the email Subject line.

**The successful nomination will be formally announced and awarded at the 2019 AIE-SA Annual Energy Awards Dinner on Wednesday 17 July 2019.**

- Non-conforming applications may be rejected.
- Requests for extension to the due date for submissions and late entries will not be considered.

- The Judging Panel's decision shall be final and it reserves the right to not enter into any correspondence.
- Nominations should not include promotional, novelty or other material / items not related to or supporting the actual application.
- Organisations nominating projects may be requested to deliver further material or a presentation to assist the Judging Panel in making a final selection.
- Projects may be shortlisted, and nominating organisations may be asked to provide additional and/or promotional material to be presented and/or displayed at the Annual Awards Dinner, on 17 July 2019.
- A key representative of the organisation nominating the project must make the following declaration:

*As a key representative of the nominating organisation, I declare that the organisation has obtained all necessary consents to the disclosure by the organisation and AIE of any specific clients / projects / results / images included in the submission and authorises the AIE to use the information within the submission as part of the a presentation at the AIE SA 2018 Awards Dinner and in conjunction with promoting the Award.*

*In signing this declaration, I also confirm that I have the authority to make the Award nomination on behalf of the nominee organisation and that all material submitted is accurate.*
