MEMBERSHIP GRADE INFORMATION

The AIE Constitution and By-Laws defines the following grades of membership:

(i) MEMBER

Being individuals who:

- (a) Hold an appropriate tertiary qualification or have satisfied the Board that they have had other appropriate training; and
- (b) Have been engaged in professional practice directly associated with energy disciplines and their application for a minimum of two (2) years at the full time equivalent after obtaining the appropriate qualification or training.

Members may use the postnominal **MAIE** after their name.

(ii) FELLOW

Being individuals who:

- (a) Possess all of the requirements of the grade of **Member**; and
- (b) Have been engaged in professional practice directly associated with energy disciplines and their application for a minimum of five (5) years at the full time equivalent after obtaining the appropriate qualification or training; and
- (c) Have either attained a position of superior responsibility, or are recognised as having a considerably enhanced status within an energy discipline, sufficient to justify the election to this grade.

Fellows may use the postnominal **FAIE** after their name.

(iii) GRADUATE

Being individuals who:

- (a) Hold a recent and appropriate tertiary qualification; and
- (b) Are engaged in professional practice directly associated with energy disciplines and their application

The grade of **Graduate** is a transitional grade of limited duration, until the graduate qualifies for the full grade of Member.

(iv) ASSOCIATE

Individuals who are engaged in, or have an interest in energy disciplines and their application.

(v) STUDENT

Individuals at tertiary institutions carrying out studies which will equip them to undertake professional practice directly associated with energy disciplines and their application.

CORPORATE

Companies, partnerships, associations, public authorities and institutions or other corporate entities directly associated with energy disciplines and their application. Corporate Members may nominate up to two (2) representatives to participate in all activities of the institute, to vote and act on their behalf in matters relating to the institute. Corporate Members may also nominate up to three (3) additional representatives at a fee equivalent to the Member Grade subscription for each additional nominated member.
