

The AUSTRALIAN INSTITUTE of ENERGY

GRADES OF MEMBERSHIP

The AIE Constitution and By-Laws defines the following grades of membership:

(i) **MEMBER – Individuals who:-**

- (a) hold an appropriate tertiary qualification or have satisfied the Board they have had other appropriate training; and
- (b) have been engaged in professional practice directly associated with energy disciplines and their application for a minimum period of two years (full time equivalent) after obtaining an appropriate qualification or training.

Note: Members may use the post nominal letters MAIE after their name.

(ii) **FELLOW - Individuals who:-**

- (a) possess all the requirements for the Grade of Member; and
- (b) have been engaged in professional practice directly associated with energy disciplines and their application for a minimum period of five years (full time equivalent) after obtaining an appropriate qualification; and
- (c) have either attained a position of superior responsibility, or are recognised as having a considerably enhanced status within an energy discipline, sufficient to justify election to this grade.

Note: Fellows may use the post nominal letters FAIE after their name.

(iii) **GRADUATE - Individuals who:-**

- (a) hold a recent and appropriate tertiary qualification; and
 - (b) are engaged in professional practice directly associated with energy disciplines and their application.
- Note: Graduate is a transitional grade of limited duration, until the Graduate qualifies for full Member grade.

(iv) **ASSOCIATE - Individuals who are engaged in, or have an interest in energy disciplines and their application.**

(v) **STUDENT - Students at tertiary institutions carrying out studies which will equip them to undertake professional practice directly associated with energy disciplines and their application.**

(vi) **CORPORATE MEMBER – Companies, partnerships, associations, public authorities and institutions or other corporate entities directly associated with energy disciplines and their application. Corporate Members may nominate up to two representatives to participate in all activities of the Institute, to vote and act on their behalf in matters relating to the Institute. Corporate Members may also nominate up to three more representatives at a fee equivalent to the Member grade subscription for each.**

Note: The Board may, in special circumstances, award the grade of Fellow or Member to a person who holds a responsible professional position in an energy-related activity but does not meet all the requirements described for that grade.
