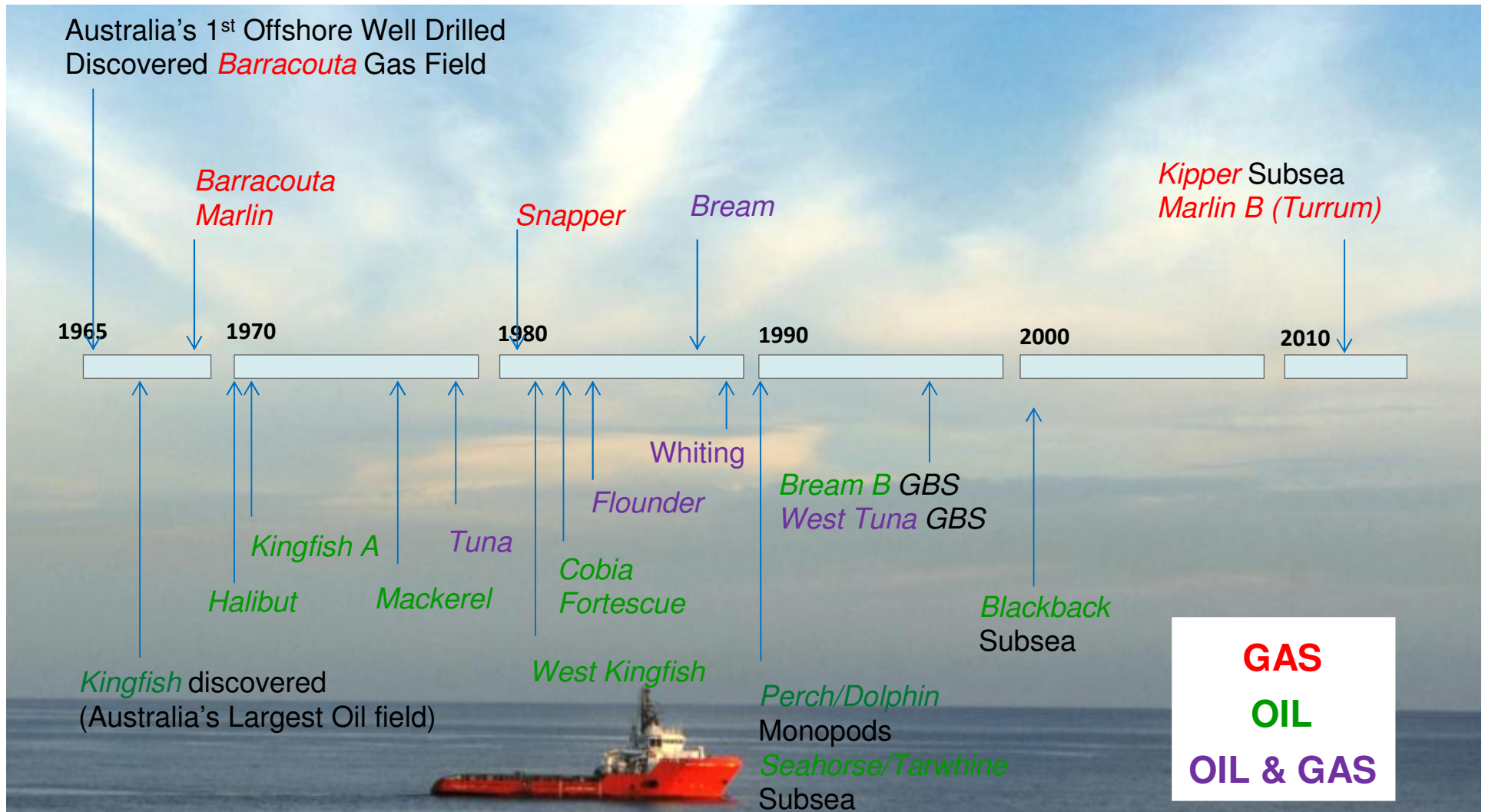
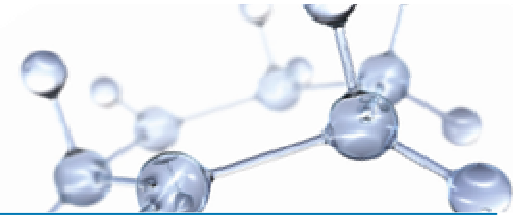


- **Bass Strait has provided energy we rely on for over 4 decades.**

- **It also put Australia on the map for global oil and gas industry investors.**

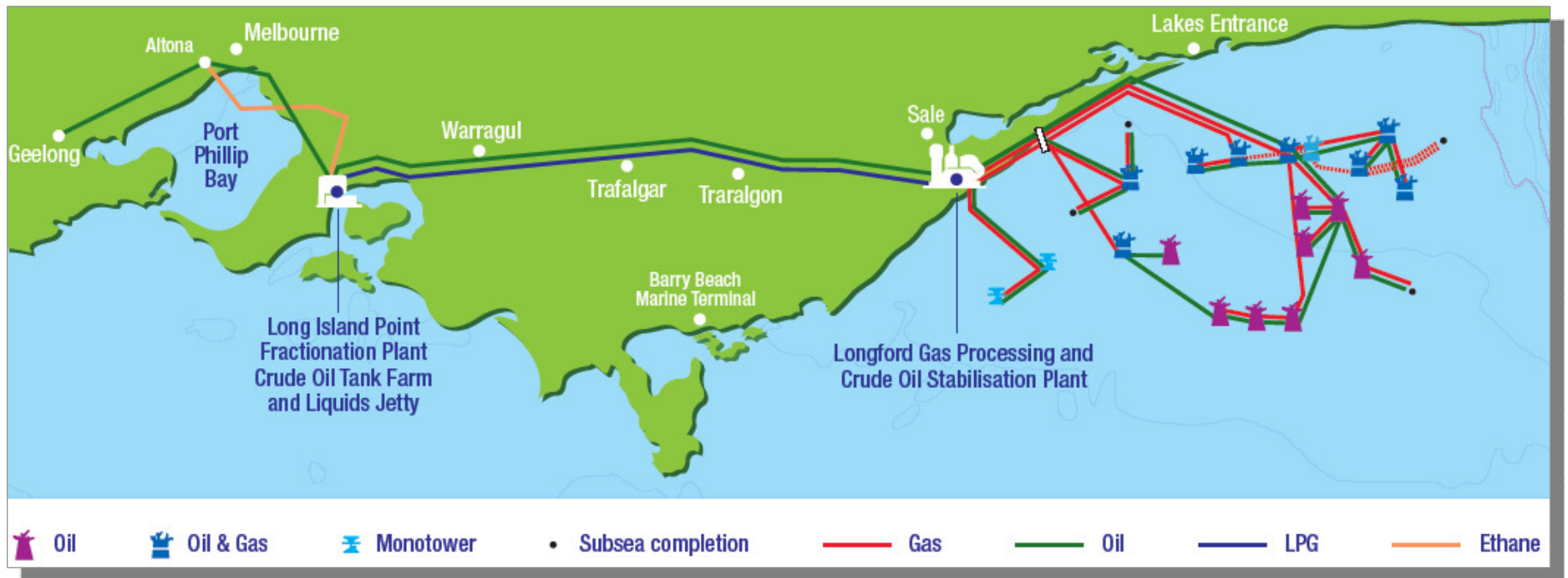
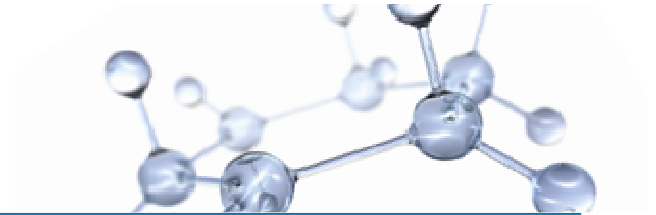




Gippsland Development Phases

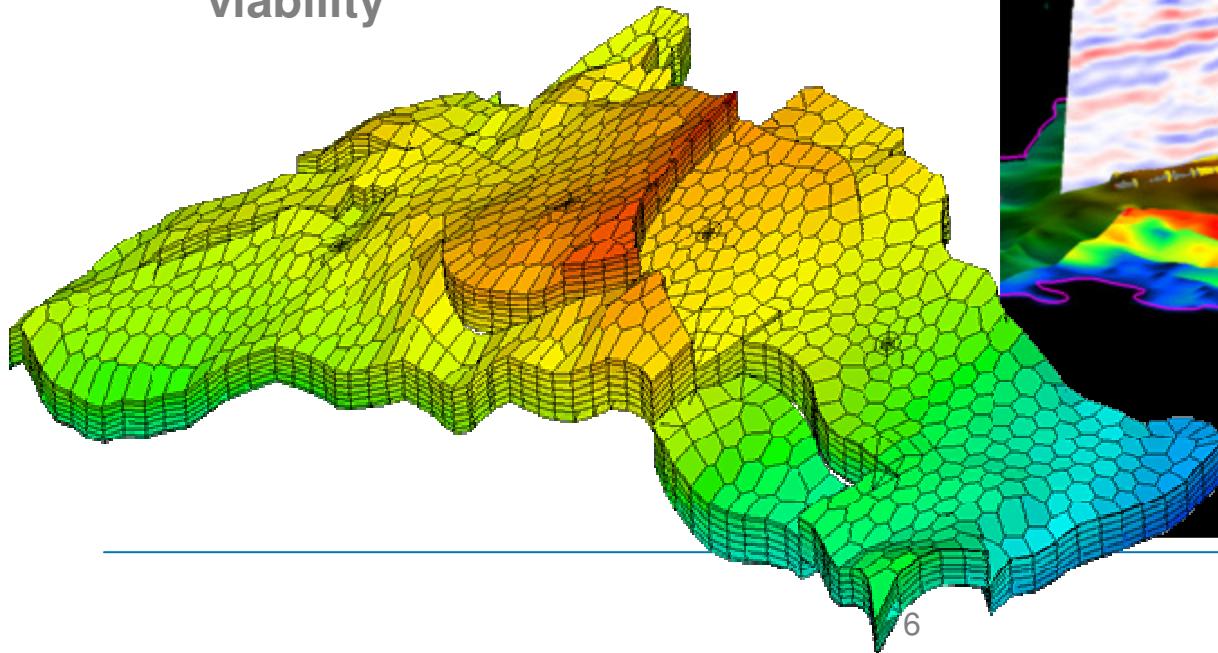
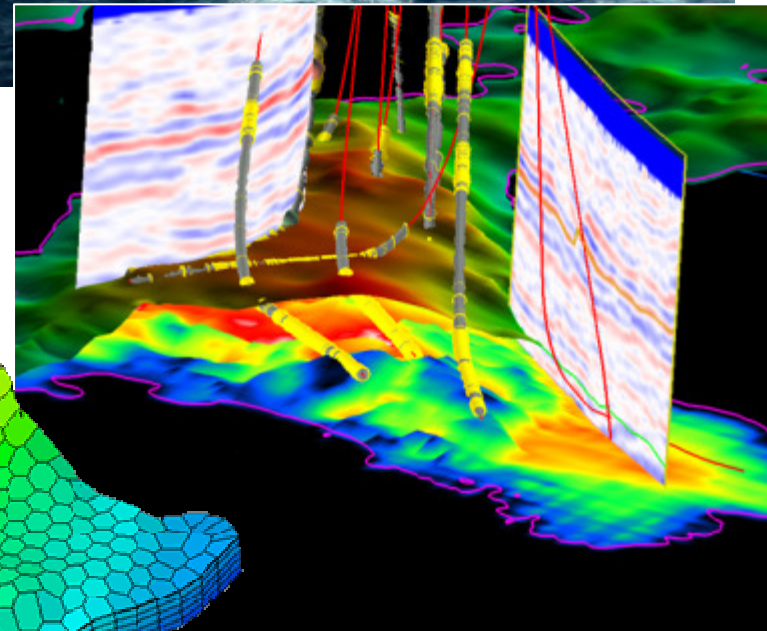
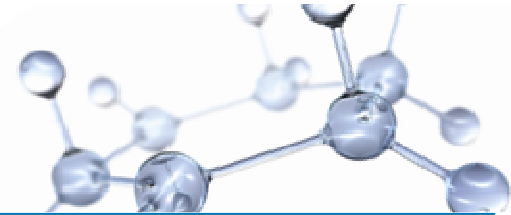


Gippsland Basin Facilities

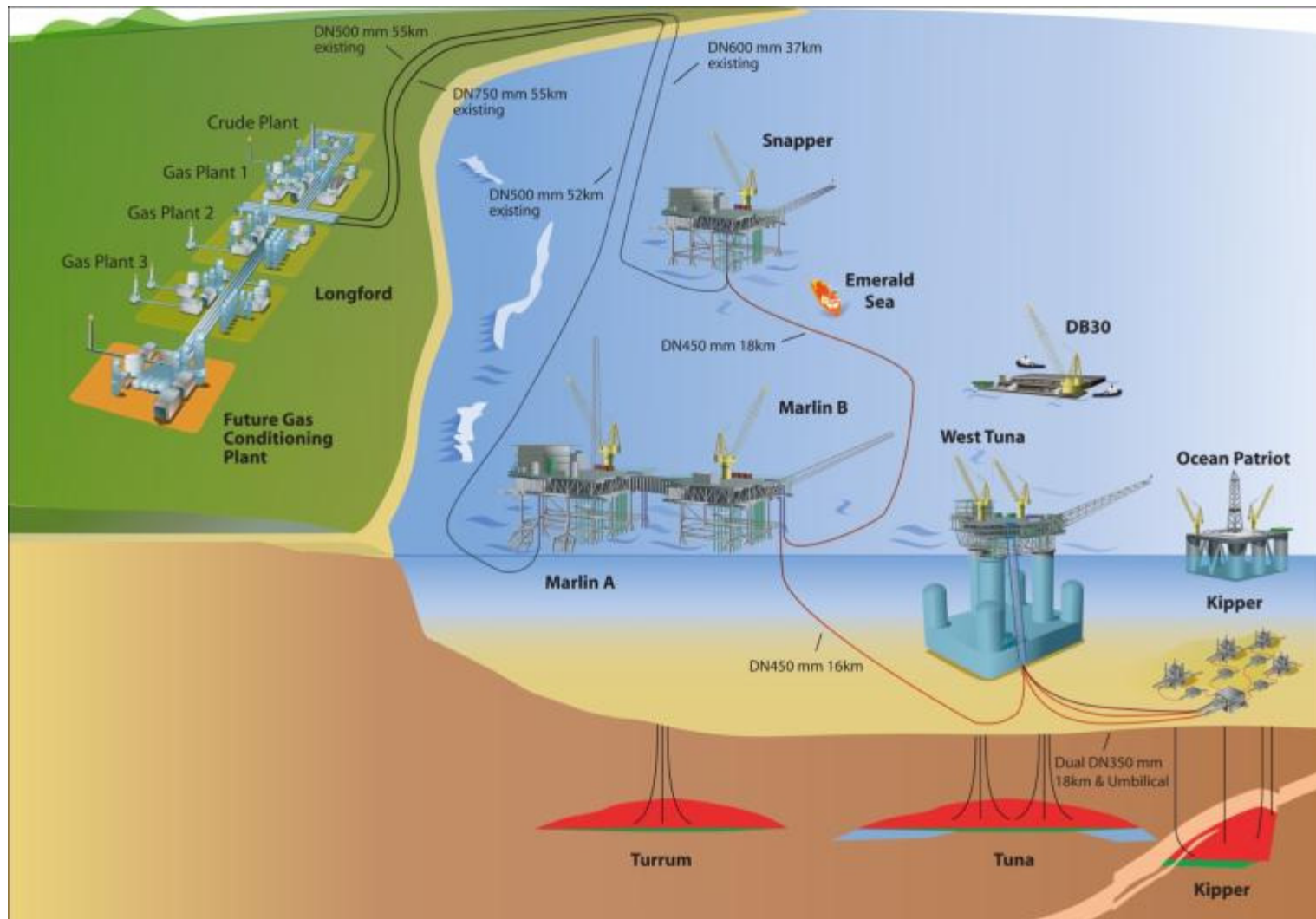
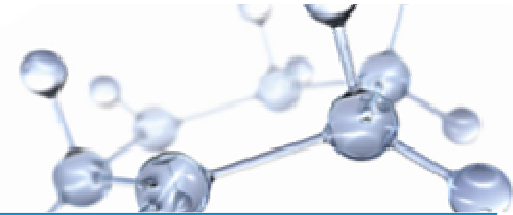


Gippsland Exploration

 - Developments ultimately dependent on commercial viability



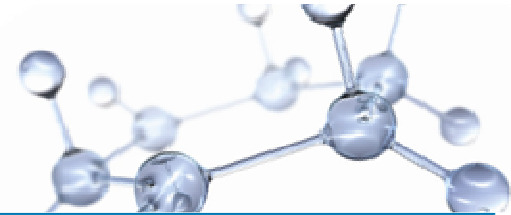
